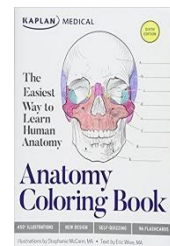
Class Description:

This is an honors course that covers both the anatomy and physiology of each of the human body's organ systems for those students who have successfully completed high school biology. It would be helpful to complete chemistry but is not mandatory. This course is designed to prepare older high school students for the Advanced Placement (AP) or College Level Examination (CLEP) tests. Sixteen modules cover human anatomy and physiology, including the skeletal, nervous, endocrine, lymphatic, digestive, respiratory, and reproductive systems. Student text includes study questions, laboratory exercises, and illustrated module study guides. **Please note that the reproductive system is covered in module 16. We will NOT be covering this module. That will be left up to each individual family to determine if they cover it at home.**

This is a rigorous college-prep course. Students should expect to spend at least 60 minutes a day completing coursework. All experiments will be conducted in class. Students will take their tests at home and bring them back to the next class session completed. Final exam will be taken in class. Weekly emails will be sent to communicate homework and test schedules.

Tuition:

Cost: \$400 for the year
