



## Medical Certification of Exemption KAT Face Coverings

In compliance with state and CDC recommendations, Kalamazoo Area Tutoring Association, Inc. (KAT) has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19. As outlined in the 2020 KAT Preparedness Plan, KAT is requiring all individuals including, but not limited to, tutors, students, volunteers, monitors and visitors, to wear face coverings when entering and exiting Centerpoint Church, when in common areas, restrooms, study hall and in classrooms.

Exceptions may include ...

- tutors when lecturing
- when eating/drinking
- brief removal to avoid dizziness, trouble breathing and/or feelings of claustrophobia
- K-5<sup>th</sup> grade students in class

KAT recognizes that medical exemptions may be necessary for some individuals. In some situations, wearing a face covering may exacerbate a physical or mental health condition, lead to a medical emergency, or introduce significant safety concerns. Adaptations and alternatives should be considered whenever possible to increase the feasibility of wearing a face covering or to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19 if it is not possible to wear a face covering.

By signing below, you acknowledge that you or your minor child has a medical condition that warrants a face covering to be removed for longer periods of time and/or not to be worn at all during participation at KAT and you hereby assume all legal responsibility for any violations that may be enforced as a result thereof.
