An in-depth course on the structure and process of writing

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Focus Group:

This class is intended for 3rd to 6th grade level students who need to build foundational writing skills in order to be confident in writing different genres.

Course Description:

This course will help young children to build a strong foundation in the process of writing that will include parts of speech, basic sentence structure, grammar and sentences variation, and opportunities to further develop listening and speaking skills in a safe and nurturing environment. Power Writing with Pizazz would provide them with tools for upper level writing.

Course Benefits:

This course will take students through the writing process, introduce and utilize writing that can be used for developing strong personal narratives, persuasive/opinion, and research writing. It has a very student friendly format that still allows for creativity and personal voice.

Cheryl has taught in the public school system, earned a Masters Degree in education, and continues to be involved in the current curriculum standards through private tutoring and maintaining relationships with families and professionals in the public/ private school systems as well as parents and teachers in the homeschooling community. Cheryl has also completed additional courses in higher education with a specific focus on developing writing skills to provide the most effective methods of teaching young writers.

Course Costs:

\$360 per student for the entire year. Half (\$180) is due the week before classes begin in September. The other half is due at the beginning of the second semester in January. (Cost weekly for this one hour and 25 minute class is approximately \$10.60. All handout materials provided throughout the year.

Course Length:

This class is a one-year program. Each semester has 17 weeks of classes. Each class is one hour and 25 minutes.
