

WRITING WORKSHOP 2

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About the Instructor:

Nancy has been teaching at KAT since 2008. She has a bachelor's degree in Elementary Education from Plymouth State College in New Hampshire and a master's degree in Literacy Education from the University of Southern Maine. About the Course:

This is the second level of Writing Workshop. Students begin where they left off in Writing Workshop 1 and build on the concepts they learned. In this class students will acquire additional tools to further enhance their writing and increase their independence. Students will learn more challenging modes of writing and advanced style techniques, broaden their vocabulary, and expand their knowledge of grammar. This class is the perfect stepping stone to a high school writing class and can easily be taken in conjunction with a grammar class.
